He participated in the 53rd Venice Biennale 2009 representing the Singapore Pavilion with his solo presentation 'Life of Imitation' which was awarded a Special Mention. In 2014, Ming Wong will present beside the solo show at carlier | gebauer in Berlin a comprehensive exhibition at the Minsheng Museum of Art in Shanghai (China).
